

## Installation Guide for AgCam Camera to CNH IntelliView Three Camera Video Adaptor Cable

- 1. Dakota Micro, Inc. PN: DMAC-CNH3.
- 2. The adaptor cable is 70" long.
- 3. This adaptor cable allows for the input of up to three (3) AgCam® cameras into Case IH AFS Pro 200, AFS Pro 300, AFS Pro 700 as well as New Holland IntelliView II, IntelliView III and IntelliView IV monitors.
- 4. The adaptor cable looks like this:
  - A. Cameras 2 & 3 (hardwire, see instructions below)
  - B. Camera 1 BNC Male
  - C. Power Input
  - D. 5-pin Female Switchcraft Connectors (Qty 3)

Camera(s)2 & 3 Outputs.

To hook the Video 2 & 3 outputs into the CNH monitors, you will need to take apart the 26 pin square bulkhead connector that goes into the back of the monitor. This connector looks like the image to the right.

A) As much as Dakota Micro would love to be able to tell you which wires go where, wire colors and locations vary dependent upon the type of equipment and usage. We recommend you take notes on which pin holds which wire color (IE: Pin 3=brown) for your own reference should you require it.



IMPORTANT NOTE: We HIGHLY RECOMMEND that you have your dealer perform this task. If you pull any of the other pins out of position while installing this cable, DM is not responsible for informing you how and where to put them back into their appropriate position.

B) To release the pin lock: Press the white locking tab on the top of the connector (identified with the arrow on photo below) with a firm object. Items such as a screwdriver or a coin work well. This will release ALL of the pins...don't pull any out, DM is not responsible should you do so!!



c) Insert your video 2 & 3 pins into the appropriate socket (make sure all your pins are firmly seated)
White Wire = Video 2: Insert into socket 8



D) To re-lock pins: Firmly press the dual re-lock tabs on the backside of the connector



6. This adaptor cable works with both NTSC & PAL AgCam® cameras.

Black Wire = Video 3: Insert into socket 16

7. As with all our other adaptor cables, warranty on this item is 1 year from date of purchase.
